


This practice allows unsafe drivers to continue to pose a risk to other motorists by allowing their continued operation on the nation's highways

This provision also requires that records of such conviction information be made available to all authorized parties and government entities. The FMCSA urges State Executive Branch agencies to work with the State Judicial Branch to eliminate the practice of masking.


Serious Traffic Violations 49 CFR 383.51

- Excessive speed 15 mph or more over the speed limit;
- > Reckless Driving;
- Traffic violation in connection with fatal accident (crash);
- > Improper / erratic lane change;
- > Following too closely





































Data Quality

- Often referred to DataQs, is an FMCSA system that allows users to request and track a review of Federal and State data issued by FMCSA believed to be incomplete or incorrect.
- Requests for Data Review (RDRs) for all States and FMCSA Division Offices

Data Quality

The system enables all users—motor carriers, drivers and their representatives, as well as FMCSA and its State

partners—to improve the accuracy of FMCSA's data-driven safety systems that help prevent crashes, injuries, and fatalities related to commercial motor vehicles. Accurate data leads to safer roads.


VEHICLE QUALIFICATION FOR DATA Q INQUIRY At least one of the following must apply: The qualifying vehicle involved in the crash is a CMV, which includes: A truck having a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of more than 10,000 pounds or a gross combination weight rating (GCWR) of more than 10,000 pounds and is used on public highways; or A motor vehicle designed to transport nine or more people, including the driver; or ANY vehicle displaying a HM placard, regardless of weight; ANY vehicle transporting placarded amounts of HM; or ANY vehicle required to be placarded.




